Cusco–kilometro 104 - Wiñaywayna - Machupicchu - Aguas Calientes - Cusco

Departure from your hotel in Cusco toward kilometer 104, where our adventure begins. Our first stop is the archaeological site of Chachabamba (2,250 meters above sea level), historically significant for its agricultural production, which was transported to Machu Picchu. We then continue our hike to the archaeological center of Wiñaywayna. Along the way, we will enjoy beautiful views of the Urubamba River and have the chance to observe various species of orchids.

We will visit the archaeological site of Wiñaywayna before enjoying a well-deserved lunch. In the afternoon, we will continue our hike toward Machu Picchu, getting a distant view of the site from the Sun Gate (Inti Punku) during a splendid afternoon. After an approximately 1 hour and 40-minute walk, we will enter the archaeological center of Machu Picchu via Circuit 1B (upper terraces) at 2,400 meters above sea level for a guided tour of about 40 minutes.

From there, we will descend to the checkpoint where we will register and leave our belongings (optional, extra cost for lockers), to re-enter (with a second entrance ticket) this time inside the citadel of Machu Picchu (entrance to circuit 3 B) with your professional guide who will take you through the incredible archaeological area, showing you its main streets, city squares, and finely carved stone stairways. Here you will have the opportunity to visit the Temple of the Sun, as well as the Sacred Plaza, the Royal Tomb, and the Main Plaza. Machu Picchu is considered the spiritual center, as the center of esoteric wisdom of the world. Once the guided tour is over, you will have free time to explore the site at your own pace.

Return to Cusco: Descend to Aguas Calientes and then board the Expedition train to the Ollantaytambo or Poroy train station. Please note that the train departure time may vary depending on the train schedule and availability. Once you arrive at the Ollantaytambo train station, our transportation will be ready to pick you up and take you back to your hotel in Cusco.





Responsible tourism that respects and protects this ancient legacy

Our **environmental responsibility** at **Inca Trail** is essential for the conservation of this cultural and natural heritage. This commitment translates into a series of sustainable practices that ensure minimal impact on the environment while offering a quality experience to visitors. Main aspects:

1. Promotion of responsible tourism

- Travelers are informed on how to behave respectfully toward the flora, fauna, local communities, and archaeological heritage.
- The number of people per group is limited to minimize impact.

2. Commitment to local communities

- Hiring local personnel with fair working conditions.

Promotion of sustainable ancestral practices and dissemination of the Andean worldview as part of respect for cultural and environmental identity.

3. Support for the conservation of Salkantay

- Archaeological and environmental conservation projects.
- Participation in cleanup campaigns and environmental volunteering.

4. Responsible use of natural resources

- **Rational water consumption:** Water waste is avoided; water from natural sources is filtered or boiled without contaminating it.
- **Sustainable camping:** Use of authorized camping areas without damaging the flora or compacting the soil in sensitive areas.

5. Staff training

- **Guides, cooks, and porters** receive training on environmental practices, SERNANP (National Service of Natural Protected Areas) regulations, and conservation protocols.
- **Environmental awareness is promoted among travelers**, informing them about their role in protecting the trail.

Light, comfortable, and broken in. Not too tight, and not too loose

At least 4 sets. Make sure they are made of breathable materials like wool or synthetic fiber

To protect your head during the cold nights
