The Salkantay trek is one of the most spectacular adventures that connect with the Archeological place of Machu Picchu, the views are made up of glaciers, mountains and the Humantay lake and a lot of vegetation, which makes this trek one of the most beautiful. We will cross the highest snow peak of the Vilcabamba mountain range until we reach. This path will finally take us to the town of Aguas Calientes, which is located at the foot of the Historic Sanctuary of Machu Picchu.

Cusco – Mollepata - Challacancha - Soraypampa - Humantay Lagoon -Lodge del Cielo

The pick up from your hotel will be approximately at 4:00 am, and then transfer to Mollepata in our private transport for around 2 hours, after a light breakfast (not included in the tour), we will continue by car to Challacancha, there we are going to meet our muleteer and horses. our trek will start in this part waking until we reach our Lodge del Cielo located in Soraypampa.

In the afternoon after lunch, we will ascend to visit the beautiful Humantay lagoon, after the visit, we will descend again towards Soraypampa, finally we will spend the first night under a starry sky in our Sky Lodge.









Day 2 Soraypampa - Paso Salkantay - Wayraqmachay - Challway





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After breakfast, we will start the most challenging part of the trek, walking through the site known as Pampa Salkantay. Then we will take the left side of the Salkantay glacier. Around noon, reaching the highest point of the imposing snow-capped Salkantay located at 4,630 masl(15,190 feet), we will be able to appreciate all the majesty of the area, it is chain of mountains, glaciers and ravines, we will feel the magic of the Andes, after a small break for pictures we will begin the slow descent towards Wayracmachay, where we will have lunch and a well-deserved rest.

We will continue descending and enter the edge of the jungle with a spectacular view of the place, and then continue to our second campsite located in Challway. After a long day finally is time to enjoy the dinner and overnight stay.

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Day 3 Challway - Playa - Hidroeléctrica - Aguas Calientes





After a breakfast, we will start our trek at 06:00 am along the Inca Trail Network. This day will be unforgettable. We continue with our trek through the jungle, through this route we will be able to see the flora and fauna of this area, especially the coffee, tea and passion fruit, plantations. The climate is temperate and humid and this forms a favorable micro climate for the production of Orchids that due to their colors and varieties, have been classified by experts as the most beautiful in the world. in addition, considering 5-hour walk to La Playa, we will continue our way in a local transportation until we reach the hydroelectrica train station, where we will have lunch and a brief rest. We will continue our way toward Aguas Calientes (walk along the side of the railway till the town of Aguas Calientes). Finally, here we are!!, get ready to enjoy the dinner and overnight stay in our hotel.



Coffee Experience



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Very early in the morning just after breakfast we will take a bus to the citadel of Machu Picchu in an ascending way for the period of 30 minutes to reach the access point and check point of Machu Picchu the guided tour will be carry on by your tour Guide for around 2 hours, in this tour the Circuit that should be the circuit 2A or 2B (please see the availability of spaces) Any of those circuits covers at around the 80% of the Archeological place of Machu Picchu in coordination with your Guide you are ready to ga back to Aguas calientes.(Lunch, not included)

Time to board the train back to Ollantaytambo or Poroy train station where the transportation will be waiting for you to take you back to Cusco.

 - Both mountains are quite high, but with very different characteristics. Huayna Picchu reaches 2,720 m / 8,924 feet, but it consists of an almost vertical ascent with much more extreme and narrow trails. On the other hand, the Machu Picchu Mountain reaches 3,000 m / 9843 feet, almost 650 meters above the citadel. The path to the top of this mountain is more demanding than Huayna Picchu, it has a wider path and can be done by anyone. Although care must be taken with altitude sickness and weather conditions
 - Walking time Huayna Picchu (45 min)
 - Walking time Machupicchu Mountain (1.5 h)
- Option: if you feel tired after the hike on day 3, you have the option of taking a train from Hidroeléctrica to Aguas Calientes.
- Additional costs or delays beyond our control such as natural disasters, bad weather conditions, itinerary modifications due to passenger health problems (suffering from a disease or health problem), pandemic, changes in government policies, political instability, strikes etc.
